### SCIENCE




We also learn new exercises. My favourite exercise is running, and I love it very much. Since my height is small, I also do jumping exercises. I am very interested in learning different types of exercises.


After that, we went to Jashipur village. Then, we visited Bhitarkanika, where we saw many different types of crocodiles and enjoyed it a lot.
