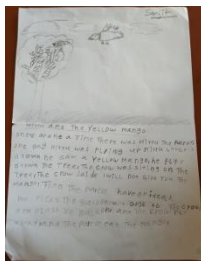


problems of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. He is good at calculating mentally. He can multiply big numbers and can divide a big number with a single digit number.
