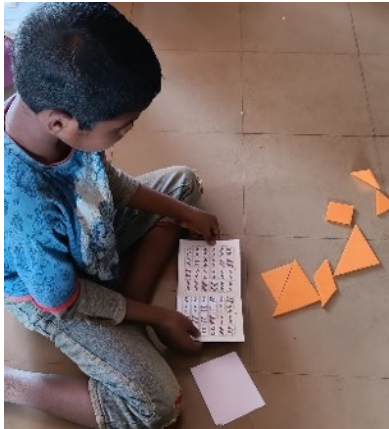

Mathematics:



Initially, Santosh did not take much time in
