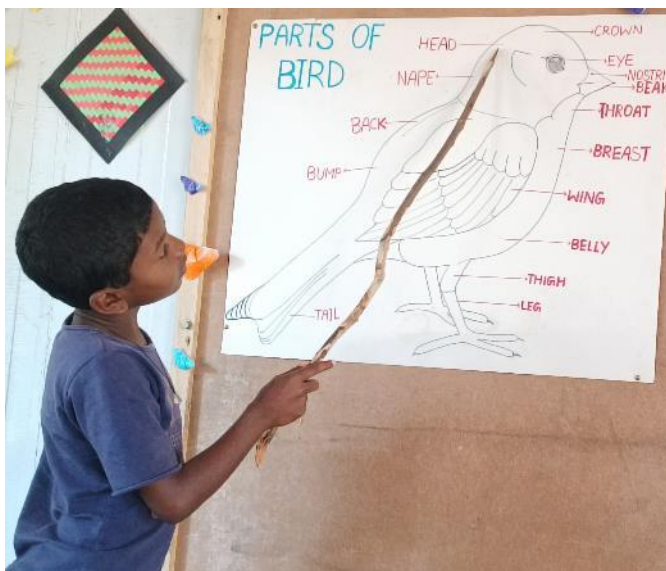
Human Body Parts:
