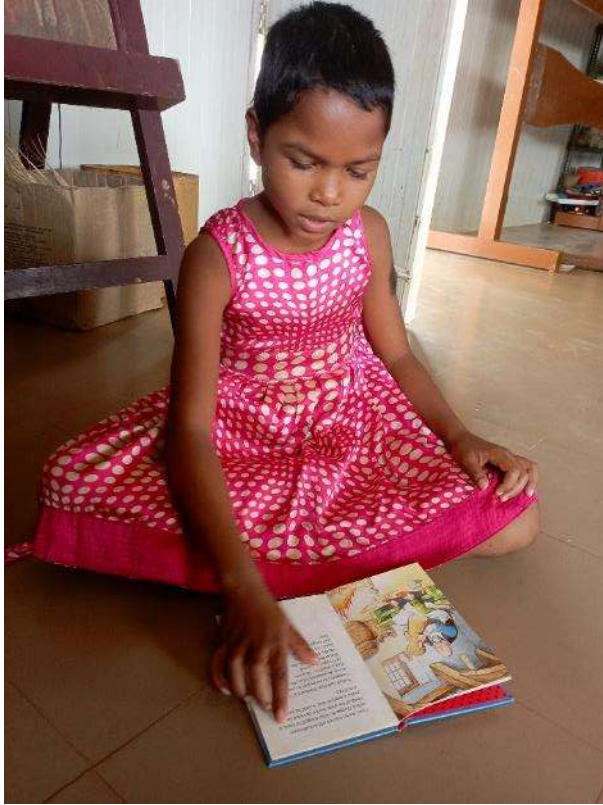

Odia

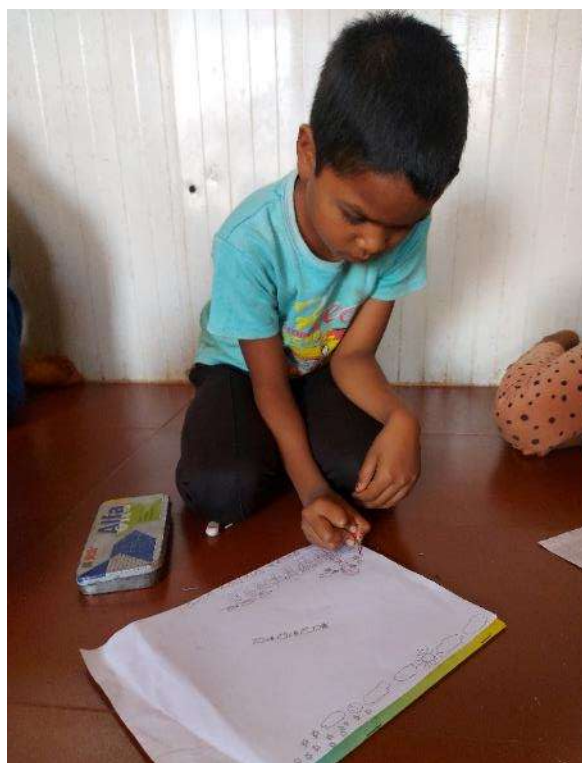
