

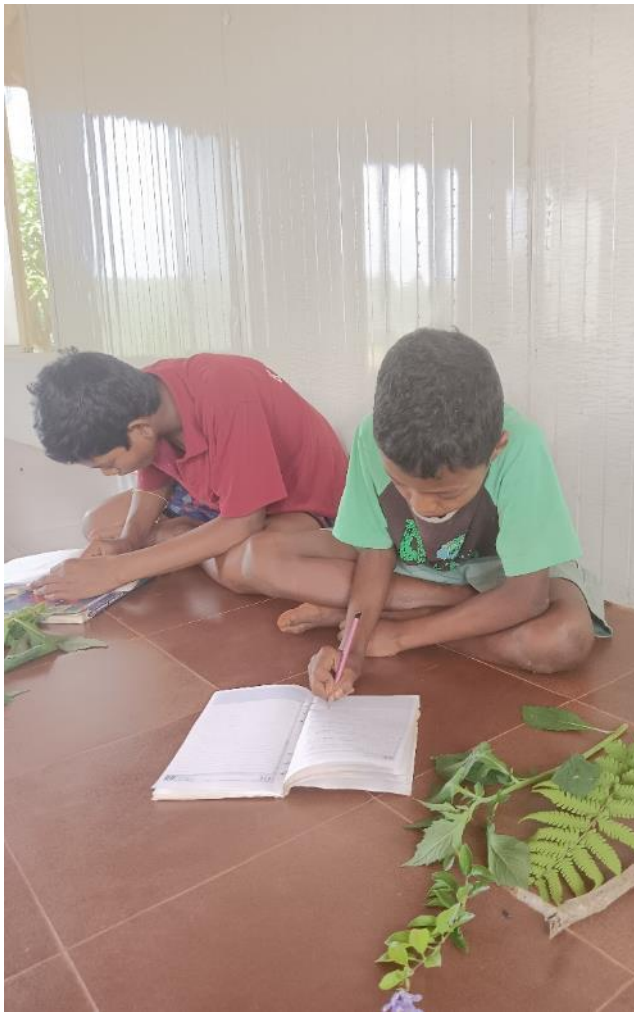

ENGLISH

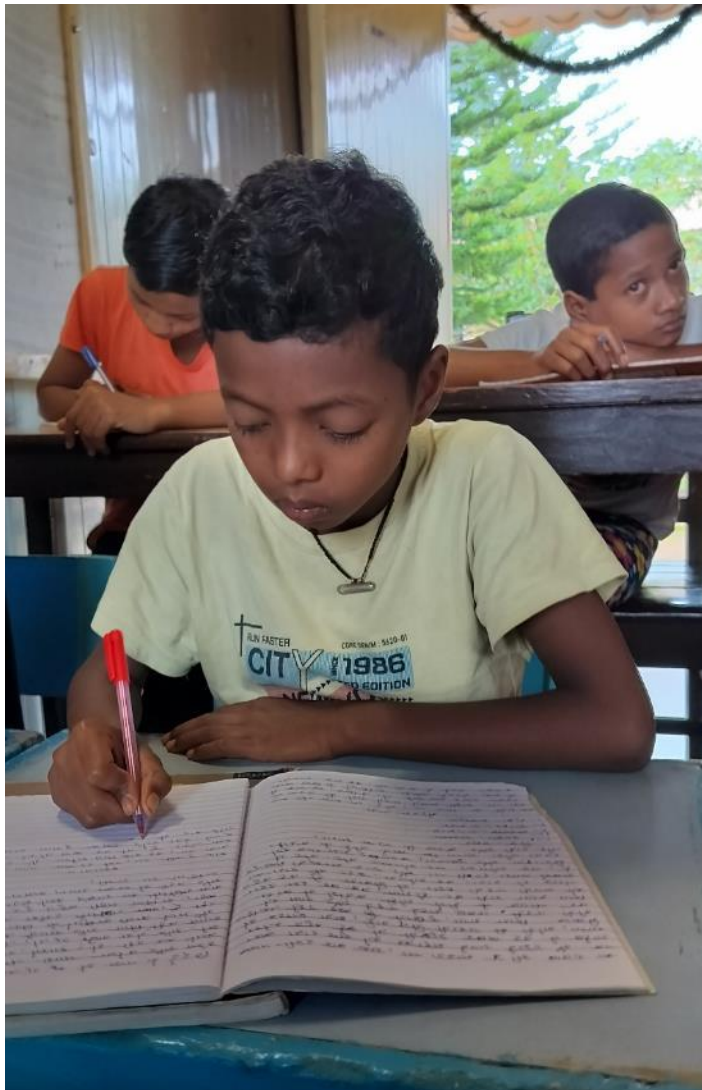

HINDI

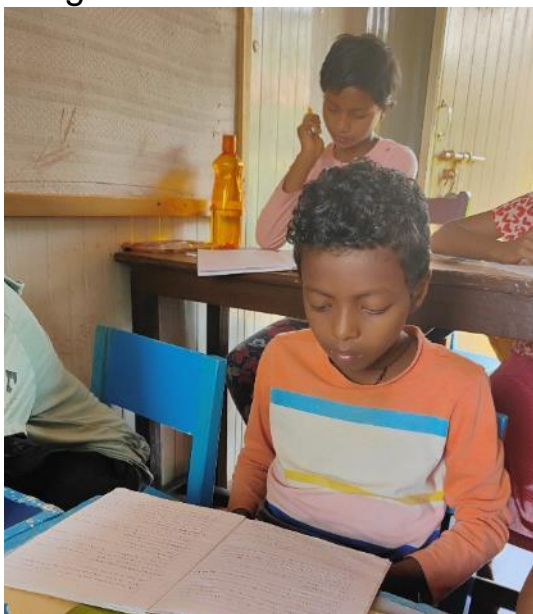
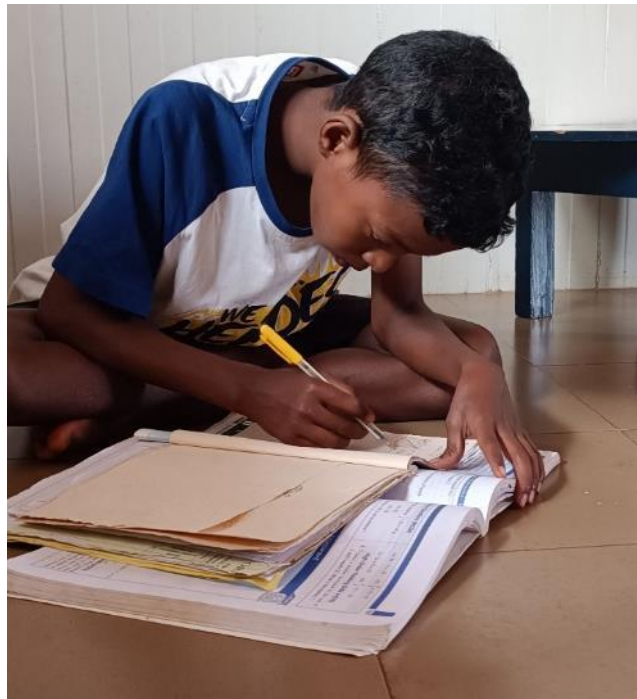

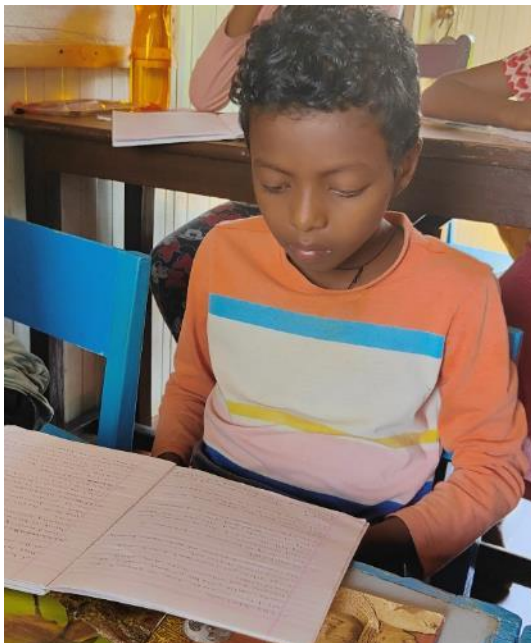

confidence. He has finished the 5th-grade book and been promoted to class 6 in science.

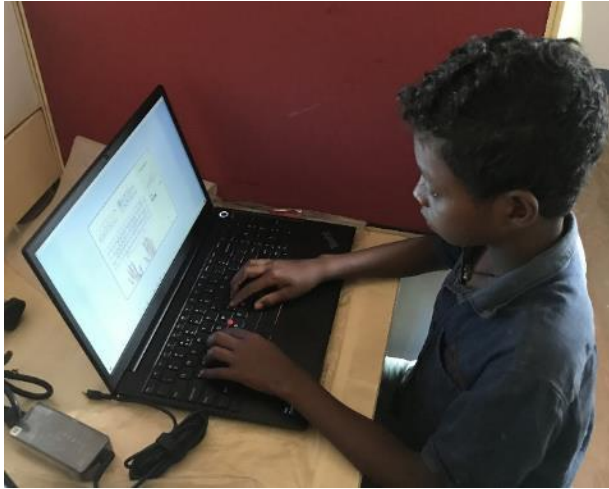
SOCIAL SCIENCE
