HINDI: She is quite an intelligent girl but speaks very little in class. Her reading is

sometimes she can't catch the words. While taking dictation, she makes some mistakes. She has completed Bhasha Drishti book 1. From this book she read the stories and answered the questions. Whenever she faces difficulties, she always comes for help. Now she is doing Rimjhim book 2. When some work has been given, she tries to complete her work and then tries to help her friends.

ODIA: Naira can read & write some words. She also sings songs and dances. She has interest in playing cards for language learning. She has a good ear.

PROJECTS:
