## Shramdan



Shramdan is something I take pride in. I contribute in the girl's hostel by performing various tasks, including toilet cleaning, filter cleaning, drain cleaning, floor cleaning, and staircase cleaning. On Sundays, I also inspect the rooms of younger children to ensure cleanliness. My regular Shramdan routine is in the morning from 6:30 AM to 7:30 AM, although it can sometimes extend if I start late. I'm very diligent in my tasks and often lend a hand to other children if I finish my work early. When it comes to specific tasks:

- **Sweeping and Cleaning the Floor:** I take care of both the south and north buildings. I start by sweeping the floor and then proceed to either wipe it by hand

or use a mop, depending on the situation. If I complete my work swiftly, I often assist other children with their Shramdan.

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- **Toilet Cleaning:** On toilet cleaning days, I gather all the necessary supplies. This





includes washing washbasins, toilets, and bathrooms. Sometimes, I scrub the walls of the toilets and bathrooms. Even in cold weather when I don't feel like dealing with water, I persevere because the work must be done.

- **Staircase Cleaning:** During staircase cleaning days, my partner and I work together to sweep the entire staircase, from top to bottom. We then wipe it clean.
- **Filter Cleaning:** I take charge of cleaning both filters in our hostel. This involves scrubbing and refilling them with water.
- **Drain Cleaning:** My partner and I tackle drain cleaning by using brooms to remove leaves and ensuring the drain is clean.
- **Sunday Cleaning:** Every Sunday, I

clean my own clothes, room, cupboards, and perform dusting with my roommates, Shampa and Tulika.
