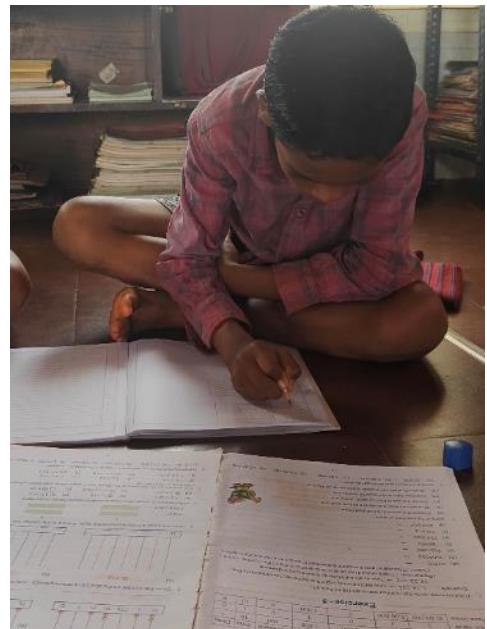
Mathematics
