currently recovering from scabies. He has made significant improvements in his academics, sports, and other areas in just two years, despite joining the school late.

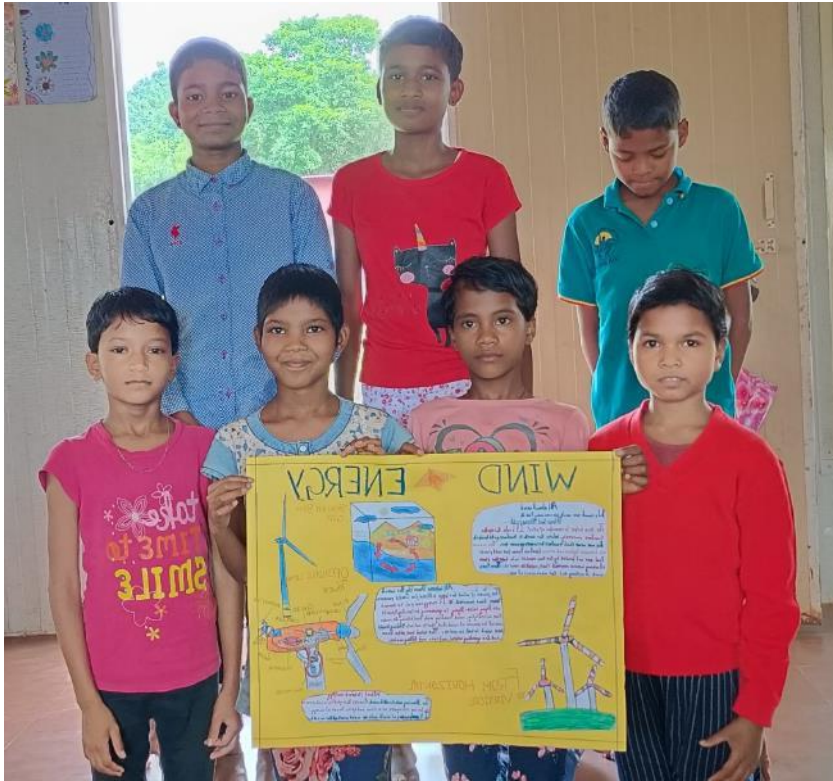
Mathematics
