
Projects

Simple Machines

Human Body



In the project on Human Body, Chaiti found it difficult to understand the Nervous system and the Digestive system. to learn it properly. Chaiti got almost average and fair marks in the various tests given to her on different systems of the Human Body. Her marks are as follow: Respiratory system-4/10; Skeleton system-10/20; Digestive system- 8/15 and Nervous system -9/20

Countries and Capitals


Hindi

English

Mathematics



Chaiti shows interest in learning Mathematics. Her concepts of all the four operations i.e. addition, subtraction, multiplication and division are clear; but she still takes a lot of time to apply them where required. She finds it difficult to remember multiplication tables and makes many calculation mistakes especially when she is solving multiplication and division problems. She has completed the textbook of Class 4. She understands the concepts but we have to explain it to her many times. Her retentive memory is weak because she forgets the concepts after a few days and

they have to be refreshed in her mind again. She has been taught international place value, number periods, roman numerals, factors and multiples. She has made good progress in converting unlike fractions to like fractions and decimals to fractions. She can convert paise to rupees and rupees to paise and solve addition and subtraction sums and word problems related to money concept.



Odia

She loves this class and can read and write in Odia quite well and concentrates while in the class. She finds it difficult to speak to others. For special days she practised some short plays with her classmates.



The Odia class is held once a week on Saturdays. She needs to concentrate more in the class to improve her speaking and writing skills.
