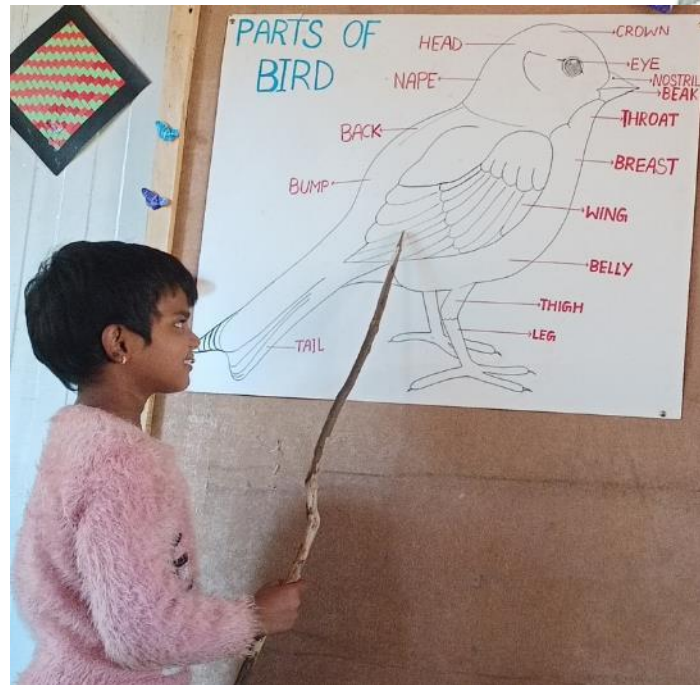


ascending and descending order. Overall, Anushka's dedication and progress in mathematics are commendable.
