Khagendra is a quiet, soft spoken child. He joined school late at the age of 6. He is regular to school. Khagendra stays neat and clean.

Khagendra is from village Ratamatiguda. He has one sibling, a younger brother studying in scour hool in the Twinkle Group.

Everyone in the group likes to be with knagendra, he is a very helpful child. He helps and supports everyone younger and older children and diyas as well.

He listens carefully, but takes time to

understand. He has difficulty in retaining anything learnt. For all subjects and activities we have to give him special attention and time so that he can grasp things.



He chants nicely in the group, but finds it difficult to do it individually.

He likes to chant OM and among prayers he likes Sita Ram, Sita Ram and Song - Chand se seetal banna seekho.

He takes lots of interest in storytelling.



ENGLISH

Khagendra is quite child. He is a slow learner, he seldom speaks in English.

The only English words he has picked up on his own are "Excellent" and "Very Good" which he uttered during one of our field trips.



He loves listening to stories and has a vivid imagination while describing the pictures from a story book.

When asked to tell a story he takes lots of time. He is creative but he doesn't get the words. He has to be continually prompted and helped to form sentences.

HIND

Khagendra speaks Hindi properly though he has some problem in speaking some letter sounds like - s, sh.

He is a quiet, ever smiling child. When he started working on the hand writing book, he was stuck on some alphabets. But he practiced so many times on the ground, with water, in the practice book that he quickly became conversant with it.



In the alphabet related drawing activity, he needed some hint questions, then he would identify words starting with a particular alphabet.

He tells long stories. Mostly he likes to include bow and arrow, rocket, sun, house in his story.

MATHEMATICS

In math khagendra has learnt to count forward, and for backward counting he can do 10-1 after multiple trials. He is clear between 1-60, after that he gets confused at 69, 79 etc.

He is starting to count by 2s but will always resort to counting by 1s. He has not yet grasped the concept of adding by 2s.



Age: 6.5 years

He initially had difficulties remembering no's after 29, 39, 49, 59... with numerous repetitions he is able to remember some of these numbers.

He has learnt to recognise rows of 10 objects and is able to count by 10's. Khangendra does simple addition also.



SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Like most other children in the group Khagendra is also interested in drawing. He does with lots of concentration.

When told to draw





by his imagination he waits for others around him to start drawing, taking similar ideas he does on his own.

If given a topic or situation to draw on he waits to start, once started he makes paying attention to all details.

He is also fond of making cut piece paper drawings, making things using cutting and pasting. While doing the nature topic he was very keen on cutting mountain shapes.







PHUSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Khagendra is not regular for games. As his home is close by, he runs away home.

In the field he likes to do exercises, play pakdan pakdai, and enjoys in the sandpit also.

During indoor play time he is fond of playing with blocks and toys.
