Math: Manish is quick to follow concepts; he listens carefully to instructions and responds accordingly. He learnt place value with the abacus with 5 digits. He is very clear in commas, writing numbers, addition, subtraction, division, and subtraction with 5 digits. He is confident in whatever he undertakes



and works independently. Manish's mental development is very good. He has learnt with 5 digits- ascending, descending and comparison of numbers. He can recognise time with the hands of the clock. He has absorbed the concept of time very well and can convert the days, weeks, months as required in the questions. He enjoys solving problems asked by his friends. He has completed class 2nd textbook in the month of March and has started class 3rd book.

English: Manish is a quiet boy who rarely speaks in class. He has really improved



in his reading of books. He has a good comprehension of what he reads. He can also explain in his own words but takes a lot of time to form sentences while speaking and to think and answer. He likes to take dictation. He can write the words

acted superbly and remembered his lines. He delivers his dialogues loudly and clearly and he acted them well. In fancy dress he got the role of a 'plumber'. He had a little difficulty in memorising the lines, but he worked hard and got them. He delivered his lines without hesitation and fright. For the Mother's birthday, he played two roles- of a tiger and a tree. He could take out the exact sound that is made by a tiger and it was amazing and fearful to hear it. He is not shy on stage. Hindi: Manish loves to read stories on his own. He has started reading stories that are a little more difficult and in small print. Sometimes he takes help from didi to correct his pronunciation and to read difficult word. font. He can identify all the "matras" by listening to the sound but has difficulty in writing some letters like- h, jh, th. He gives full attention to his work and does not

get distracted by his friends. But sometimes he encounters difficulty and takes help from didi. He also helps his friends to recognise the letters and words. He loves to use new words in his daily life like- samajhna, ashcharya chakit.



He enjoys doing dramas and he plays his role beautifully. In Fruits topic he learnt to make sentences by learning the names of the fruits. He also learnt the nomenclature for tastes. During the birds' topic he played many games. His favourite game was identifying the



bird. Most of the times he could identify the bird which he had learnt. He has learnt to write stories through Ganga topic, and he has developed his vocabulary too. In the river topic he learnt to write poems.
