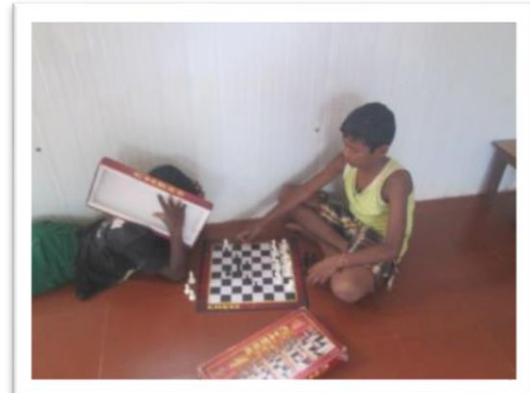
He writes well, he focuses well but he makes many mistakes as he has his spellings mixed up. He likes to write stories.
