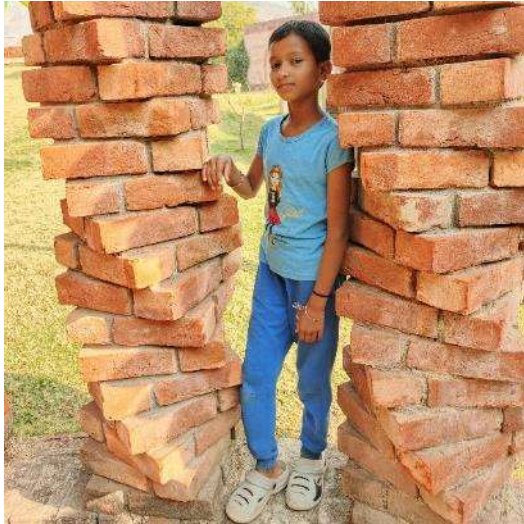


# Jahnvi Gouda

### **Shramdaan**
