Introduction

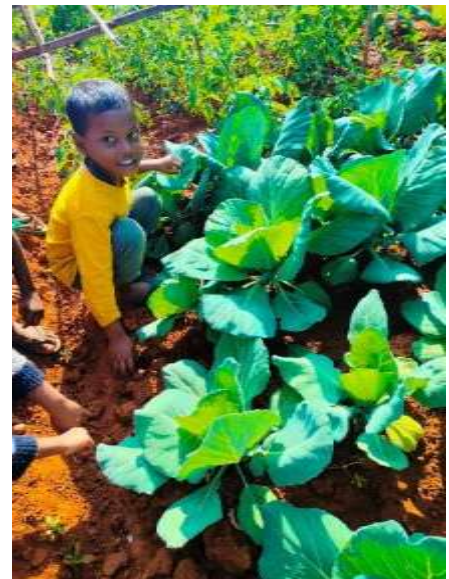
