## Math

Prabhat is interested in math. He has completed book-3. Now he is revising to get clarity. He concentrates for a long time to do math. He learnt roman numerals till thousand and is able to convert Arabic numerals in to Roman numerals. He could do division of 3/4 digit numbers and learnt new terms such as dividend, divisor, quotient and remainder. He can check his answer using formula of  $\text{Dividend} = \text{divisor} \times \text{quotient} + \text{remainder}$ . In measurement he is able to identify which units will be used for weight, volume and length. While solving word problems, he reads the questions independently and knows which operation should be done to find the answer. He has learnt the Indian and International place value; he did many exercises to understand place value. Initially he found it difficult to read and write the number names of 8 digits, later he did it. In fraction, he is able to recognize unit fraction, like fraction, unlike fraction, proper fraction, improper fraction and mixed fraction. He could arrange unit fractions and like fractions in ascending and descending order. In time he learnt the use of quarter past, quarter to, half past etc.





## Odia

Prabhat's concentration is good. He is not interested in acting and singing in Odia class. He has now started reading and writing. He is doing book 2. Prabhat is a very punctual student in the group. His concentration is good. He likes to read and write perfectly.
