She is peaceful even in A difficult situation, she confronts it with confidence.


Though it is difficult for her, she gathered the strength to tell a story to a large group of children, in English.

She likes to sing but tends to make up words that she doesn't remember and lip sync at times.








She remembers her lines after some effort and has the habit of being uncorrectable at times but she tried very hard on both occasions when Flower group performed plays in English.

Math: Bhakti can count more than 100 serially.


She is able to recognize and write numbers and also number names.

She listens carefully and pays attention in the class.


She can read with the help of Didis. Most of the time she feels shy to express herself. She reads with good pronunciation. Her writing skills are average.
