He also likes to explores what the older children are doing in class.


He can't sit still if he hears the sound of a motor boat, tractor or motor cycle, he has to watch them.

English Language - Gupto is still getting around being comfortable with alphabets, though he knows all of them.

He is a good story teller and loves to recount his exploits with group mates and friends.

He speaks in English but wanders off into Hindi when he wants and switches back when asked to.

Responds well to individual attention but sometimes becomes picky about activities.








He had trouble remembering lines for the first play but came through after repeated practice, done separately from the group.

He played the Hen in the second play and picked up lines quickly.





Hindi Language - Gupto does not pay attention in class so he is unable to progress much in reading. When doing copy writing he is able to do nicely.

He is unable to express himself and write also. He needs continuous special / individual attention to improve.

Odia Language - Gupto has learnt to read and write a little in Odia.

He is a slow learner. Though he is regular to the class, he has low concentration level.

Most of the time he is interested in outdoor activities. When given personal attention he listens and obeys Didi's instructions.


Math: It has been observed during these six month that when Gupto gets some free time, he gets his math book and does addition and subtraction.

He is able to get the answer of what comes after, before a number and what is the number in between.

He can arrange the numbers up to 100 in ascending and descending order.

He is able to do the addition and subtraction of two digit numbers with two digit numbers without using objects.







He has got concept the of place value of tens and ones.

Skill work: Gupto remains engaged while doing skill works cutting, pasting, painting, rubbing, paper folding etc, but he likes very much to do cutting and pasting work.

He sits for a long time in one place quietly till his work is finished.

In Projects and Activities done during this session, it has been seen that he is more expressive than before.

Verbally he is able to describe his experiences in detail in English.


He put good effort to make story, riddle, song etc.

Games and Sports: Gupto is regular at playing games and doing exercises.

He has developed his stamina; he can run 15 minutes continuously without getting tired.

He likes to play football, base kick ball and any alertness and suppleness games.

Sport's Day - initially Gupto was struggling to stand in queue and do movements / postures based on instructions given. After a lot of practice he learnt all the actions and performed well with the group.
