In terms of addition and subtraction, Prabhu is making strides in his learning journey. He can confidently solve problems involving two digits with one digit and is beginning to tackle two-digit subtraction problems, albeit

with some hesitation. When he arrives at the correct answers, Prabhu exhibits genuine joy and satisfaction.

Puzzle

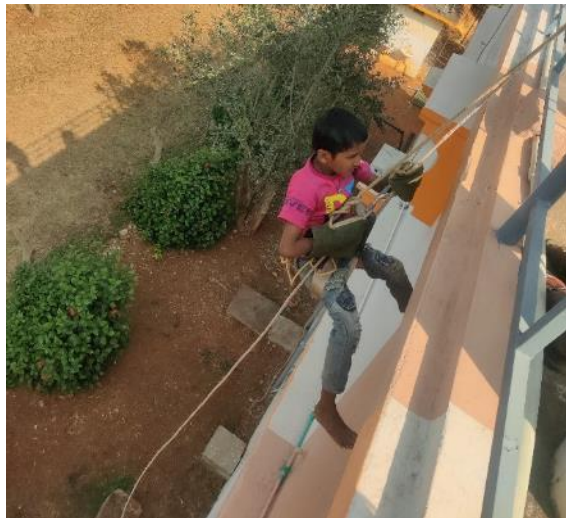
