**Report for 2022-23**






But sometimes, she is not able to clean herself after toilet and whenever she feels the need to go to toilet, she doesn't inform didi. In chanting time, she sits properly but cannot do the chanting and sometimes just moves her lips.

## **GAMES**

Suchitra is a disciplined girl and plays the games silently. She never talks with anybody, never fights,

or complains about anybody. But most of the time she just keeps standing. When we tell her to run or do the exercises, even then she doesn't move.

### ***LANGUAGE (Hindi)***



In singing time, Sujitra likes to sing the songs with actions in funny animals' songs. She likes the songs - "Bhalu ki shadi main jayenge" and "O sweet Mother". She feels very happy and gives a big smile when her favourite song is sung. She sings the songs in a very low voice due to some physical issues that she has. In



story- telling time, she sits nicely and listens to the stories. She can give answers when didi asks questions, but sometimes she just sits quietly lost in her own world. She likes to do drama, but she takes time to say her dialogues. She only says her dialogues in a few words or in one sentence. Still, she had performed a play on Janmashtami. In creative story-telling, she only tells the names of the objects which she draws on the paper. Her voice is very soft, and she speaks very little in the group. When didi asks anything, she nods her head.

## LANGUAGE (English)

Sujitra likes to sing the rhymes with action. She especially likes the rhymes with animal sounds and actions. Her favourite rhyme is “Chai-chai”. She sings this rhyme very softly. Her pronunciation is quite good, but she takes time to remember the lines. She speaks very little in the group. During story-telling, she can understand the story when didi tells it with action



and sound. For language development, she did a play “The enormous turnip” in the assembly. She spoke her dialogues in a very low voice and took time to remember them.

## MATHS



Suchitra is a silent girl and she doesn't talk with anybody in the group. She is a good listener and her voice is low due to physical issues that she has. She listens to everything attentively and when didi asks her questions, she is able to give the right answers. She has learnt 1 to 100 forward counting and “after and before numbers” till 20. In number recognition, she learnt



very fast and made beautiful patterns with Rangometry. She likes to play with Rangometry. Her memory and pronunciation are good.

### ***CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES***

Suchitra likes to do drawing. She draws the things around her group like tree, balloon, kite, flower, heart shape, square, butterfly etc. She always likes to do drawing of potato. Her drawings are

small, but she can give proper shape and colour to the drawings. But she takes more time than others to colour the pictures. After finishing her work, she keeps her things in their respective places. She does not like to do paper folding. Due to her physical issues, she faces problem in rolling and tearing the paper. Her concentration is good and she is slowly developing her motor skills.

Sujitra likes dramas. Her voice is very soft and low. She does not like to do her acting alone. She always likes to do



it in a group. On the stage, she keeps looking at the
