Lily comes to school regularly. She joined school early this year. She has learnt how to eat properly, is toilet trained and has learnt to keep herself clean. She always comes to school neat and clean. During circle time she sits nicely and does chanting. She has learnt all the chants that other children know. She enjoys animal songs. When new songs are taught, she takes time to remember and to learn the correct pronounciation. She does not open her mouth and often mumbles what she has to speak.



Math activities:-

Some monts ago she would sit quietly in the group. Whatever was asked, she would only nod. But now she is very smart. She has learnt big and small, heavy and light, colours, forward and backward counting, after number, before number and between numbers till 20. She can recognise numbers up to 20. She can mentally add and subtract up to 20 through creative stories and objects. When didi asks questions, she can think quickly and gets very excited to tell the answer. During activity time, she sometimes gets distracted and talks with her friends. She likes to do activities in nature. When she joined school, she could not even understand Hindi and would just sit quietly. She would converse with her friends in village language. Now her Hindi is developed and she can understand and express her thoughts nicely. She can tell stories and can explain her drawings nicely. She can tell over ten sentences by her own thinking. Her pronunciation is good. She asks questions when she has any query. She takes interest in all activities and she is very attentive. When didi teaches some songs, she sings well and

learns quickly. Her memory and thinking power is good.

English:

Language Hindi:-

She sits properly in class but is sometimes in her own world. When she listens carefully to the story, then she answers the questions asked by didi. She has learnt only a little bit of English as she is a new student in school, but she tries to create and tell her own stories. She participated in the rainbow play where she played the role of fox. In this play her partner was Gaurav. She could memorise her dialogues and also learnt the song. She did the acting of fox very well. On Christmas she sang Christmas song with her group.



Skills work:-

Six month ago she could draw very little and would only scribble the crayons on paper. Now she draws and paints very nicely. Her motor skills are developing. She likes to do clay modelling. She can tear the paper and do collage and makes collage



nicely. She can do paper folding nicely and has also learnt making some toys by paper folding. She can colour the pictures very nicely. She can make patterns with birds. She takes times to do the activity.



Project:-



In project class she learnt about her family. She learnt the relationship with her family in Hindi and English. She made her family tree by drawing and painting. She said only 3 to 4 lines about her family like-

There are 4 members in my family- mummy, papa, grandpa and me.

My father goes to the field and cultivates vegetables.

My mother helps him and I help my mother to clean our house.

Physical development:-

She likes to play in the sandpit. She likes to play with sand, slide and on the play equipment in the sandpit. But she does not like to play with her friends. When she does, sometimes she pushes her friends. She runs very slowly. She does not like to play running games. She gets tired when she runs and when we go for trekking. Sportsday- On sportsday she couldn't perform dumbbells perfectly. She couldn't keep with the music. She was just looking at the audience.

Celebrations:-

She takes part in all school programmes. When she goes on stage, she looks at the decorations. She can remember her dialogues and her voice is loud and clear. She does not have stage fright. She likes to dress up for programmes. She performed a dance on Independence Day and on Janmashtami. She played the role of rain in the play "nanha beej". For Ganesh puja and Saraswati puja she sang songs with her friends. For Diwali she made diyas with paper folding to decorate the group. On Pranjal bhaiya's birthday she performed in the play (rainbow) in the role of fox. She did it nicely. On Christmas she took part in an action song with her friends. On Mother's birthday she sang a Sanskrit song and students' prayer with her group mates.
