

Faith Group Report **2022-23 (First term)**



Introduction-

Faith group has 13 students. All of them are doing their graduation. The youngest two have turned 18 in August'22 and oldest two have completed 21 years. Two would be completing their B.A (Hons.) in this academic year. (Bikanti in Psychology and Kamli in History). Seven would be

completing next year. Basically, only those children who insist on remaining here and at the same time are disciplined and self-motivated stay on in Kechla.

India has a dearth of good teachers who are willing to work in rural areas. The children who stay on in Kechla volunteer in helping with the younger groups. The duration is usually 2 to 3 periods per day. They also take other responsibilities. During Shramdaan they not only work themselves, but also motivate and oversee the younger children. They help on the field during games as well. They help in organising programmes. This is bringing out an all-round development in the students. They are becoming mature, responsible and confident.





All of them are studying from IGNOU. One is doing B.Sc; one B.Com (Hons.) and the rest have taken subjects of humanities. Most of their own classes are conducted online. They study their various subjects either individually or in groups. They have a tough time as IGNOU is going through a transition, having recently changed from the annual system to the semester system.



The syllabus has more than doubled. Books and study material is not coming on time. Assignments are not released on time. Many of these students are the first ones to be appearing in these exams, hence the previous years' papers are not available. But all the students take it in their stride and don't allow this to come in their way.
