


**Rajesh Pukia**

Projects

*Simple Machines*

Rajesh loves to play and is very interested in all kinds of physical activities. He took time to remember the different types of simple machines and even more time to write about the wheel and axle for the chart making. For the presentation, Rajesh and Pranav had made a small vehicle with wood and cardboard to show the wheel and axle to the children. He spoke very little during the presentation.



*Human Body*

In this project he learnt about different types of systems in our body by reading books, discussions, drawings, watching videos and preparing charts. Nervous System and Circulatory Systems were difficult for him to understand; so, he responded very little in the class when doing these two systems. For all the other systems he was confident and scored good marks in the tests. During the presentation he was confidently explaining about his own parts. He drew good diagrams and explained them well.

## *Countries and Capitals*



He showed a lot of interest in this topic as he found going through the Atlas very interesting and located the countries and their capitals with ease and also wrote down their names. By using various memory techniques he learnt how to locate the countries in their respective continents. It was a bit difficult for him to remember the names of countries and their capitals; but he tried his best. He also enjoyed playing the Atlas game in the group. He took up Sierra Leone for a detailed study. He studied about its crops,

language, location, climate, clothes, flag, vegetation, art, dance and music. He was able to answer the questions that were put to him.

## *Civilizations*

In this topic, he learnt about the Indus Valley Civilization in detail and got a basic idea of our earlier civilizations. He was able to give details on religion, occupation,



trade, seals, tools, script and their town planning of Indus Valley Civilization. He made a few mistakes in the question-answer session. Rajesh prepared a beautiful chart with his friends. His presentation was about the arts and crafts of the Indus Valley Civilization. He found it difficult to pronounce the names of some rivers but eventually after a lot of practise, he succeeded. He scored well in his test.

### Mathematics



Rajesh is presently doing the book of Class 4 (Composite Mathematics-4). He likes to solve multiplication, addition, subtraction and division sums. He faces a little problem while understanding the language of the questions of the word problems. He did the topic on Money easily and can recognize the coins of denomination of 5 paisa, 25 paisa, 50 paisa, etc. He also learnt comparison in Money topic and took the coins and traced them in his notebook. For better understanding of Money, he learnt how to play the game of 'Monopoly'. He takes a test on a weekly basis with the rest of his group. He needs special attention in

mathematics and needs to be reminded again and again to concentrate while studying the subject.

### English

Rajesh works hard to improve his English. He is able to read many children's storybooks excluding comics. His pronunciation is good but he needs improvement. Though he can read some of the tough



words but has a problem in understanding their meanings. He has learnt about nouns, pronouns, collective nouns and abstract nouns with his group. He is slow in his grasp of these topics but did his homework somewhat correctly. His attention span is less and he needs to be reminded to focus more while studying. He can recite some lines of the poem, “Who” written by Sri Aurobindo. He tries his

best to understand some concepts and takes the help of the teacher when he is unable to understand the difficult ones. He performs well in the dictations and his spellings have improved a lot during the last six months. He can comprehend and answer the easy questions but depends on the teacher for the tough ones. He needs to be more focused and concentrate more in order to read more books and also to correct his sentence structure.

### Hindi



Rajesh is currently doing the book of Class 3. He was earlier doing the Class 5 book but could not cope with the difficulty level of that



book and was unable to answer the questions of that book; so, he was given the book of the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. He is distracted and his concentration in the class is needs to improve. While writing Hindi he makes mistakes of some matras. He took part in a play performed on July 5. He had got the role of Himraaj.

### Computers

In this class he is doing typing master and has learnt how to do painting on the computer. He likes to draw many things like house, tree, clouds, etc. He is doing his typing course too, and there are routine tests that he has to take

to check on his progress.

### Odia

Although Rajesh is a slow learner but still he tries to improve his handwriting and reading as a compensation. He needs special attention. But he has progressed a lot from before.
