Hindi

We have completed the syllabus of both the books of class 10 of NIOS. I like to do Hindi class. Krishna didi from Delhi who was here for a small vacation, taught us Grammar. I

enjoyed studying from her. Poonam didi who was also from Delhi

and had come for a month, taught us spiritual things through stories along with studies. I can read and write well



in Hindi. In Hindi my handwriting is good. In the class we also do free reading sometimes for a while. In the class, I concentrate sometimes and sometimes don't. We have learnt writings such as paragraph writing, letter writing and essay writing.

English

In English, we are studying from the 10th class book of NIOS. We read the stories and poems given and do the question and answers once we've understood the text. We also do the Grammar exercises given at the end of every chapter. I like to do questions and answers. We have completed the 1st book and have covered two chapters of 10th class of NIOS. In English class didi teaches us writing work also such as 'notice writing', 'report writing', 'letter writing', and 'paragraph writing'. Now we are giving tests on each chapter of the 1st book. I've scored good marks in some and average marks in the others. Other than studying from



the course book and doing writing works, we do free reading also once a week. I love doing free reading because we get to read interesting stories every week. Mathematics

In this period of April to September, I have completed almost the whole of 1st book of 10th class, NIOS with just one chapter of Instalment buying remaining. I have started the second book of NIOS 10th class. The chapters which I have completed from second book are Statistics and Mensuration. Now I am doing Geometry. The chapters where I need more practise and confidence are Mensuration and Geometry. I have to practise more word problems by solving them. When I am not able to solve some problem then I go to Bhaiya to understand. The chapters where I scored good mark are 'Percentage and its application', 'Linear equation' and 'Lines and angles'. In the chapter 'Quadrilaterals' I scored average marks and had to give a retest. After giving a retest, I was clearer in most of the concepts.

SCIENCE

I like to do Science class. We have nearly completed the chemistry part of the 1st and 2nd book of NIOS 10th class. We have



done some chapters of Physics and also some chapters of Biology with Meeta didi. The chapters which didi taught us I

understood properly. In science, we did practical Raghu with Bhaiya on electrolysis, parallel series and circuit. In the class we done have many experiments such as how formed salts are and whether checked the substance is acid or base. In Physics class did we



experiments such as how the rays are formed in concave lens and convex mirror.
