He is always exploring his surrounding environment and remains happy.


He has a good relationship with older children from other groups.

Hindi Language - He focuses in Hindi class. He listens to words carefully and is able to convert it to correct spelling.


Sometimes when we children write about a bird, animal, event or any other topic, he is able to form sentences and write properly. At times he makes spelling mistakes.

If any questions are put forth, he uses his memory and experiences and thinks in different ways.


He loves to do the variety of worksheets for matching, crosswords, jumble words, fills in the blanks etc. If it is difficult, he takes a clue, and finds the answer.
