Hindi:

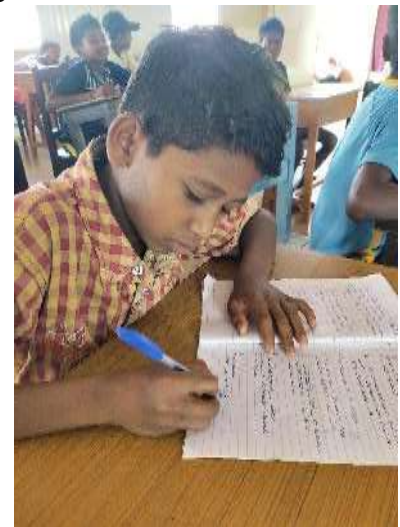
Currently, I am studying the 6th class book in
