Santosh is a quiet boy. He sits quietly while chanting. He is not fully toilet trained. He chants and sings softly, but if it is a song he likes, the volume increases. He does not like to do action of the songs. His pronunciation is not clear. He takes time to learn new songs. At times during class, he does not concentrate and goes into a reverie.

Math activities:-

He takes time in picking up new concepts. He has learnt counting from one to ten through objects. He learnt matching the pictures and arranging the numbers in sequence. He can do four to five pieces puzzles. He has learnt forward and backward counting, after and before numbers, between numbers with objects till 20. He can add and subtract one digit numbers. Sometimes he does not understand the question. He is given special attention.

Language

Hindi:-

He can create six to seven lines stories. He always makes stories of his daily routine.

English:

Santosh can create his own stories in English. His sentence structures are grammatically incorrect but he tries his best. He can understand English stories and he is able to answer when something is asked.

Skills work:-

Santosh likes to do paintings and clay modelling. He can draw clouds, trees, flowers, butterfly and other drawings he makes by scribbling crayons. He takes time to do collage, cutting and paper folding.

Project:-

In the project "my family" he could speak 3 to 4 lines about his family. He learnt the relationship with his family in Hindi and English. He made his family tree by drawing and painting.

Physical development:-

He likes to play with his friends on the field. He thoroughly enjoys playing games. At games time he laughs but at other times he rarely laughs. He also likes to play in the sandpit by digging holes, jumping, sliding and doing cartwheel. He is a strong boy. He doesn't get tired by running, playing and trekking. He also likes to play with blocks. Sportsday- On sportsday he did dumbbells with his group.

Celebrations:-

He participated in all school programmes. He takes time to remember the dialogues and dance steps. On stage he doesn't look at the audience, but looks at the decorations. He speaks his dialogues softly. He feels shy on stage. He played the role of rain in the play "nanha beej". He participated in the dance performance on Independence Day and Janmashtami. On Pranjal bhaiya's birthday he played the role of blue bird in the play "rainbow". He did it very nicely. On Ganesh puja and Saraswati puja he sang the songs "jay Ganesh deva and teri vinaki ban jaun tar" with his group mates. For Diwali he made diyas by paper folding. On Mother's birthday he sang a Sanskrit song and recited students' prayer with his friends. On Christmas he did an action song with his friends.
