effectively. In the play "Suraj ki Pariya," she portrayed the role of the sun with ease, displaying enthusiasm and enjoyment throughout the performance.





Maths

Rina is a very nice student. She can add and subtract two-digit numbers very nicely. Now she is learning to write three-digit numbers up to five hundred. She has also learned many


concepts like ascending and descending order, after and before numbers,
