Introduction

Ranjit is a talented child from Janiguda, a village just behind the boys' hostel. He stays at home due to health issues, which makes him quite irregular at school. As a result, he is unable to participate in yogasana, shramdaan, satsang, and even games. While he can go for games, he often chooses not to attend. His irregularity leads him to miss many classes and activities, making it difficult for him to catch up with his peers when he returns. He struggles to understand the context taught in class because he lacks the foundational knowledge. Ranjit was performing well in his studies before his health problems, but he has gradually lost interest in his academic work. We hope he overcomes his health issues, begins attending school regularly, regains his interest in studies, and catches up with the other members of his group.



Mathematics

Ranjeet is an intelligent boy. He is able to learn concepts quite quickly. However, he is lagging behind as he has been absent for long periods due to health issues. He is attending only one class in the morning, where new concepts are taught. He is able to learn them and complete the questions given in class. However, he struggles to solve questions from the book and is therefore unable to catch up. He is working through the Class 4 book of New Enjoying Mathematics. He started the book on 6th June but has only been able to complete a few chapters. He is unable to attend the evening class in which his group practises questions from their own books. He has gained some understanding of the calendar as he attended regular classes when it was covered. Unfortunately, he missed many classes when factors, multiples, and fractions were discussed, as well as during the revision of time and measurement. As a result, he has been unable to grasp these concepts.



Science

Ranjit is a bright student who is often absent, causing him to miss important topics. However, he has good handwriting and enjoys participating in class. He earns good marks on tests and is always ready to answer questions. Ranjit completes his homework and engages in activities related to the chapters, including chart-making and experiments. He has created a chart on water energy and recalls its features, enjoying the process. He began with the class 3 book in June and



is now working on the class 5 book, eager to learn and ask questions.

Social Science

Ranjit enjoyed learning about the different stone ages and about the different types of weapons that the people were using to hunt and to protect themselves. He was greatly amused to see a



video of people making weapons using the stones and the bones. He learnt many new words such as Palaeolithic, Mesolithic, Neolithic and Microliths. He with his classmates visited the ruined building near the school where drawings of people's daily life are depicted, and he drew a picture of the people going for hunting. He needs to pay more attention in the class. He tries to answer the questions whenever asked. He has a good handwriting and likes to keep his

notebook neat and tidy. He tries do give his best in the test and aims to do better. He lacks confidence and more interaction can help towards it.

English



Ranjeet is able to speak in English, but due to his extended absences, he is out of practise. As a result, he feels a bit shy to talk and remains timid when he comes to school. However, he enjoys spending time with his friends and talks to them more. He answers when asked but rarely contributes on his own during classes. He is working on the Class 3 comprehension book. He tries to understand the contexts, such as the stories and poems, and attempts to answer the questions

at the end of each chapter. He approaches teachers to clear his doubts. He needs improvement in sentence formation. He loves reading books, so he reads whenever he has time. He also enjoys reading stories from his comprehension book, especially when he is able to understand them properly or is guided. He is currently working on the grammar of Class 2 and has a basic

understanding of nouns, pronouns, adjectives, verbs, and prepositions. He is close to completing the book.

Odia

Ranjit is good at spoken Odia but requires encouragement to read and write in class.
