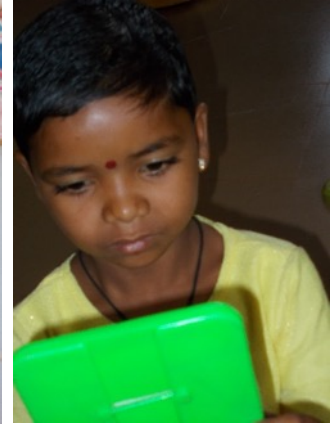

After finishing her food, she washes her plate and rinses her mouth properly.

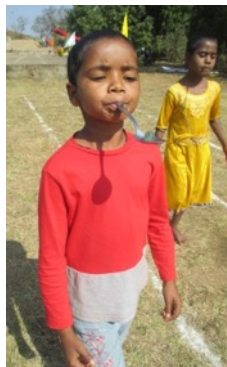


Sanitation
