Vaishali comes to school every day. She comes neat and clean and wearing clean cloths. She can clean herself after using the toilet. She is friendly with other children, but sometimes she complains about her friends. She normally eats all food, but sometimes she does not like to eat some of the vegetables. She likes to eat curds every day. In chanting time, she sits and chants all the mantras, but most of the time she plays with her clothes and limbs.

LANGUAGE (Hindi)

Vaishali is an attentive but talkative child. During chanting, she always closes her eyes and chants. Some time she also leads the chanting. Her voice is loud and clear. She enjoys singing songs, especially animal songs, with action. She can remember the lines of the songs very easily. She listens attentively to the stories being narrated from picture books. She likes to see the pictures. In story-telling time, she gets distracted, starts talking and

complains about her friends. When didi asks her to narrate the story that has been told, she is not able to do so. Her thinking ability is good. She can make stories of 5 to 8 lines by herself by making drawings. Sometimes, she tells the stories in words. For her language



development, she participated in some short plays. Her voice

and pronunciation are good. She had done a play on Janmashtami in which she played the character of villager and was able to do it well.

LANGUAGE (English)

Vaishali likes to do all the activities in the group. She has



improved her pronunciation. She is eager to do everything. She likes to sing rhymes and to learn new rhymes. She also likes to learn new songs and to listen to stories. She listens carefully to all the stories, and she can easily understand them. She asks questions when she has a doubt. She likes to make the sounds of the animals. She likes all types of storybooks. She knows the colours and the number of objects there are. She has learnt two rhymes:

“Chai chai coffee coffee” and “Old MacDonald had a farm”. She enjoyed doing the action of these rhymes. She learnt these rhymes very fast. She did a play called “The enormous turnip”. She had taken the role of girl for which she learnt her dialogues very quickly.

MATHS



Vaishali is a disciplined and attentive girl. She is always present in the class. She learns everything very fast. She learnt forward and backward counting till hundred clearly, but she has problem in backward counting as she can't tell the number before the tenth place. She can tell “after and before numbers” till 100 without any objects.

GAMES

Vaishali is an intelligent and energetic girl. She plays all the games nicely and happily. But her speed is not good, and she gets tired very fast. While doing running she never gets tired or stops to talk with others. She likes to play, run, and do exercises but she is not very flexible in doing exercise but tries her best. She understands the game very quickly and always wants to be pursuer first.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
