## Mathematics



He is confident in word problems, asking questions when needed. He has mastered reading time on both 12-hour and 24-hour clocks, converting between formats, and handling various time-related calculations. In the calendar chapter, he learnt about ordinary and leap years, enjoying the exercise of calculating his exact age in years, months, and days. He has a strong grasp of multiples and factors, successfully solving problems related to LCM and HCF using both prime factorization and short division. Mahendra has demonstrated clarity in the number system, understanding both Indian and International formats, and he can convert between them. While he initially struggled with fractions, he



quickly regained confidence, learning to compare and perform operations on fractions. He has also progressed in his evening class, covering various chapters from the 5<sup>th</sup>-grade book, including decimals and simplification.

Mahendra is one of the brightest students in his group, exhibiting great curiosity and enthusiasm for learning. He consistently earns excellent marks on





Mahendra is an intelligent boy with a keen interest in learning English. He quickly grasps concepts discussed



in class but sometimes becomes bored during group discussions. To keep him engaged, he is occasionally assigned tasks to occupy his time. He helps classmates who

may lag behind and is able to communicate in English better than before, though he needs more practise for fluency. He corrects himself when given feedback. Mahendra enjoys reading fairy tales, mythology, historical stories, and novels, and he participates actively in group readings. He pays attention to spelling, which helps him perform well in dictation. Currently, he is working on a 3<sup>rd</sup>-grade comprehension book and understands both the questions and some poems easily. While he can form decent sentences for answers, he needs to focus on proper sentence structure. Mahendra is also working on grammar exercises from a 3<sup>rd</sup>-grade book, showing clarity in components such as nouns, adjectives, pronouns, verbs, and articles. He can differentiate between the four types of sentences. He has learnt synonyms for 24 words and scored full marks in that test. With a creative mind, he occasionally writes good poems and stories during class. Recently, he wrote about his dream of becoming a soldier and serving at the Pakistan border. While he covers content well in writing, he needs to focus on improving his handwriting, which tends to be better when he is reminded.

## Odia

Mahendra is an active learner who enjoys participating in Odia dramas and conveys his thoughts expressively. His pronunciation is exceptional, and he can read and write well.

## Arts and Crafts
