Introduction

Mathematics

This time, Kirti has shown significant improvement in maths. She listens attentively in class and is gradually building confidence to participate in group discussions.

After exploring decimals with her decimal kit, she grasped the concept. She could easily relate decimal places to whole number places, making sense of their values. Converting decimal numbers to fractions and vice versa became second nature to her. With confidence, she compared numbers using greater than, less than, and equal symbols. Not only that, but she could also arrange numbers in the correct order. Sometimes, she needs help understanding word problems involving division. She is able to perform all four operations, but she needs reminders to place the decimal point correctly.

Moreover, she is gradually developing her understanding of the concept of time and calendar. She confidently converts hours to minutes, minutes to seconds and days to hours. However, she finds addition and subtraction a bit challenging, especially when the problems involve carryover





and borrowing. When working with dates, she takes some time to determine the starting and finishing dates accurately. With practise, she is steadily improving her skills in these areas.

Science

Kirti is a sharp girl. She is able to understand most of the concepts in science but sometimes needs extra explanations and attention. She likes to write and solve the question answers of the chapters very much. She used to make a lot of errors with the spelling of words but has improved a lot in her vocabulary and spelling. She is shy about asking her doubts. She is normally quiet in class due to her shyness but is always active and focused.

Social Science
