Projects

Simple Machines

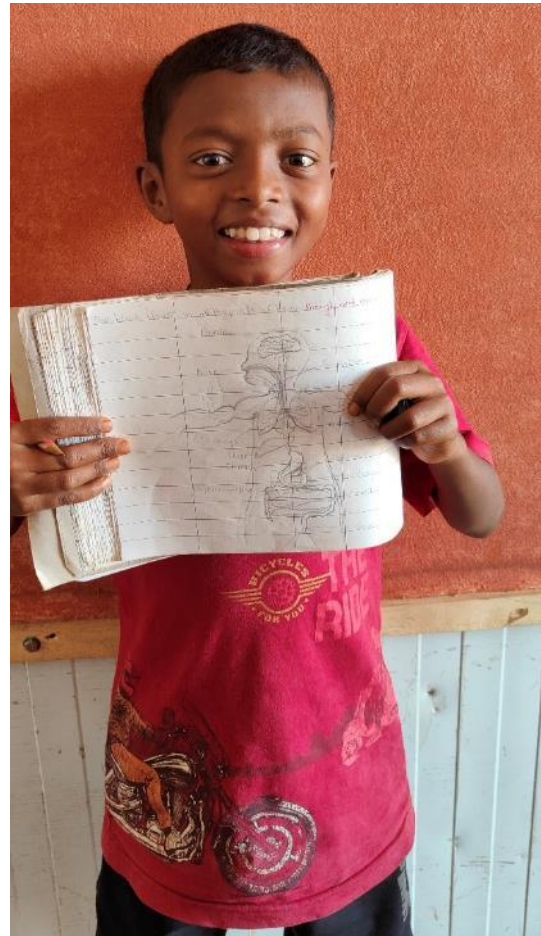
He had made a nice diagram of the digestive system in his notebook and had coloured it very nicely. He memorized all the parts of the digestive system and their functions.

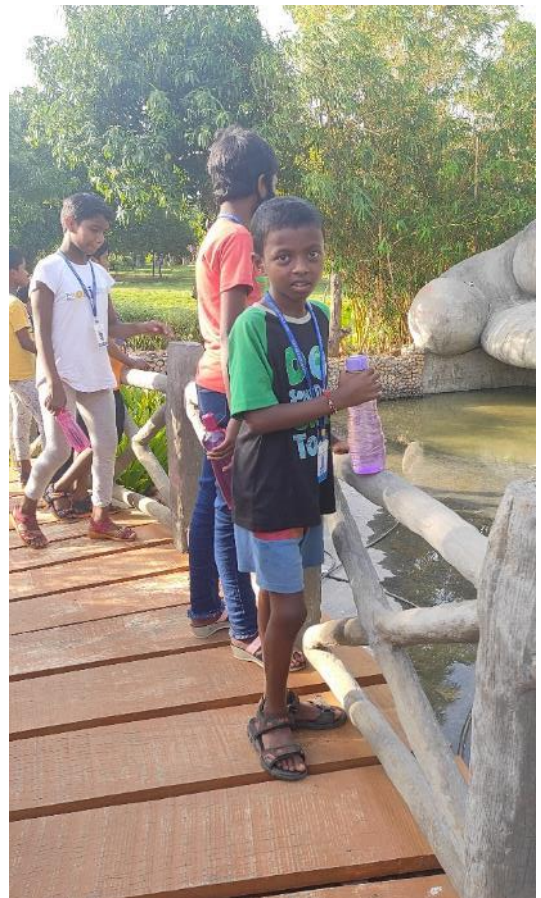
