BHAJAN:

Sanat's attention span has increased. He is a good singer and sings loudly and clearly. He memorizes the songs very fast. He finds it difficult to say the Sanskrit words while chanting. He is a shy boy so hesitates to sing with actions.



ENGLISH:

Sanat can understand English and can communicate well in the language. His sentence structure is mostly grammatically incorrect but he still likes to talk with his friends in English. He is very attentive during the story telling sessions and answers the questions at the end. He can make stories from his imagination. He cannot pronounce some words like treasure, miserable, ask, etc. correctly. He is able to read three and four-letter words without help. He enjoys singing English rhymes and songs but hesitates to do actions.



HINDI:

Although Sanat is able to understand the stories he reads and hears but he is unable to think of a story from his imagination. He needed special help and attention to learn reading. He can now read words without matras but makes a lot of mistakes in dictation. He can identify 7 to 8 words with each alphabet and can make 8 to 12 sentences on a topic given to him. Sanat has to make a conscious effort to make an improvement in Hindi.



MATHEMATICS:

Sanat takes an interest in maths. He has improved in both counting and calculation. He is able to count forward and backward till 100. He can add and subtract till 20. He can arrange the numbers in ascending and descending order till 100. His concept of odd and even number is clear. He is confused during reading time. His concept of place value is clear only till the 100th place. He can write the numbers and his writing is legible. He was able to solve basic number problems from the book with a little help.



PROJECTS:

Topic: Seasons

He learnt the names of all the seasons. His favorite season is spring because there are lots of flowers blooming during this season. He showed a lot of interest in learning about seasonal flowers. He also learnt the names of the seasonal fruits and vegetables. He made a drawing of Dahlia flower. He also observed that in spring season, some trees shed their leaves and new leaves come.



Topic: Vehicles

He showed enthusiasm to learn about different vehicles. He remembered their names quickly and drew their pictures. He was also taught the rules of road and traffic signals and he understood the concepts. He made a model of motorbike with cardboard. He also learnt what are the special functions of a fire engine and an ambulance. He could distinguish between the three means of transport.



Topic: First Aid

Sanat learnt basic First Aid in general and learnt how to keep a wound clean and apply medicine on it in particular. He picked up facts about a few medicinal plants and their usage. He was already aware of the few plants that they use in his village. He made a chart on the medicinal plants.

Topic: My Body Parts

He learnt the names of the body parts but it was difficult for him to remember the difficult words like intestine, kidney, lungs, circulatory, digestive, etc. but he

managed to learn their basic functions. He drew the diagrams of external body parts and discussed about how they helped.

Topic: My Family

Sanat was keen to talk about his family members. He loves his grandmother a lot as she used to take care of him. He learnt the names of relationships both in English and in Hindi. He drew the pictures of his parents and spoke on how they helped each other at home. He participated in the discussions and answered the questions.

Topic: Weather

He learnt that there are different types of weather and drew their pictures. He enjoyed the outdoor activities and observed the changes in different weathers. After many repetitions, he learnt the names of different clouds but he could not differentiate between them. He remembered the names of planets.

Topic: Food

His participation in this topic was quite a lot. He made the drawings of protective foods and colored them carefully. He learnt about different types of food and vitamins. He also understood the difference between healthy and junk food and stopped buying chips and soft drinks. Now he buys sweets or biscuits. He made a chart on different grains grown in the village.



Topic: Shelter

He learnt that there are different types of houses and made very good drawings of them. He also understood that there are different rooms in a house and who are the people who help us to build the house. He was curious about how people lived in the ancient times. He participated in the discussion of why we needed a shelter. He also learnt the names of the shelter of animals. He enjoyed this topic a lot.

FESTIVALS:

He got to know about different festivals of India. He participated in the discussions about a few festivals which we celebrate in the school. Although it was difficult for him to remember the names of all the states yet he came to have knowledge of some new festivals from other states and their important days. He found it difficult to memorize the dates of the national days. He made drawings of some festivals and colored them very brightly.



ART AND CRAFT:

Sanat likes to do quilling and make designs with cutting and pasting. He made a beautiful Rakhi with beads. He showed an interest in origami and collage and could remember the steps of making a boat, fish, aeroplane, etc. in origami. He manages to finish his work on time and takes good care of the materials he uses.



GAMES:

Sanat is good in all types of games. He is a short boy but runs very fast. He has a good stamina. He has a supple body and does the asanas very well including the stretching exercises. He enjoys fun games. He can climb a tree like a monkey and is not afraid to jump from a height. He participated in gymnastics and performed well in the annual Sports Day.



CELEBRATIONS:

Sanat participated in all the programmes and he was quite good. He was alert but at times got nervous on the stage. On the occasion of School's Birthday, he chose the character of a crow.
