She always comes to school neat and clean and wears clean cloths. She sits nicely at chanting time and enjoys chanting. Her pronunciation is not good. Sometimes she only mumbles. She enjoys animal songs with action during circle time.



Math activities:-



She is the eldest in the group. She can identify different shapes and can tell the difference between big and small, more and less. She can count forward and backward till twenty without objects. She can tell after, before and between numbers till twenty. She can recognise the numbers up to twenty. She has learnt addition and subtraction up to twenty through creative stories and objects. At times she can tell mentally without using any objects. She likes to play with blocks and makes different objects. Sometimes she is unfocused in the class.

LANGUAGE

Hindi:-

She likes to listen to stories. She can tell five to six line stories, but she can't make stories in a proper way. She cannot express her thoughts in full sentence. She makes pictures and tells stories by her own creation and in words and not in sentences. She has learnt the external parts of body, colours (through Hindi rhymes), names of some fruits and vegetables. Her pronunciation is not clear. Sometimes she can't understand the questions. She often fidgets. Sometimes during storytelling, she does not pay attention and is in a reverie. She takes time to think and answer. She acts beautifully during dramas in Grandma and Granpa roles. She thinks deeply about the situation and expresses her feelings through drama. She loves to take any corrector given by Diya's and think of her own story and performed with her friends nicely. Many times her friends got stuck in between and helped them. She speaks fluent Hindi among her friends and has capacity to learn and remember fast, but needs confidence.



English: -

She can understand English and tries to speak. She can tell stories in broken English. She likes to sing English songs. In the English play she played the role of grasshopper. It was difficult for her to remember her dialogue but she finally managed. She participated in singing on Christmas.

Skill work:-

She likes to paint. Her drawing skill is developed. She can draw colourful flowers, house, butterfly, clouds and tree. She likes to arrange buttons and objects on the drawing. She also likes to do clay modelling.



Project:-



In project class, she learnt the relationship between her family members in Hindi and English. She drew her family tree through drawing and painting. She said these five sentences about her family-

- There are five members in my family- mummy, Pramila di, tapan, namita and me.*
- My mummy is the head of my family.*
- Mummy takes care and makes food for us.*
- My mummy loves me very much.*
- I bring wood, clean the house and my eldest sister Pramila di stays in the hostel.*

Physical development:-



She is older than the others in the group. So she can run faster than them. She likes to play with her friend Anjali in the sandpit with kitchen sets. She likes to play running games like chain game and white tiger with her friends. Sportsday- On sportsday she did dumbbells very nicely with her friends.

Celebrations:-

She feels very excited before programmes and celebrations. She likes to dress up and apply lipstick, kajal, foundation, bindi, etc. She takes time to remember her dialogues. Her voice is not clear. She has no stage fear. She did the role of monkey in the play "nanha beej" and performed dances on Independence Day and Janmashtami. On Ganesh puja and basant panchami she sang a song with her friends. On Diwali she made diyas and helped to decorate the group. On bhaiya's birthday we did a play in which she played the role of a grasshopper. She participated in an action song on Christmas. On Mother's birthday she sang a Sanskrit song and a students' prayer.
