Sushila comes to school on time every day, but sometimes takes holiday. She comes neat and clean from her home. She is toilet trained. She eats all vegetables and doesn't waste food. In circle time she sits nicely, but as the day goes by, she sometimes gets fidgety or gets into a reverie. She usually chants properly, but sometimes prefers to sit quietly.



Math activities:-

In math she has learnt from 1 to 20 forward counting with objects and counting rhymes, arranging the objects in sequence and match the pictures in sequence. She can solve 4 to 5 pieces puzzles. She likes to learn in the nature and through games. When asked questions, she sometimes can't understand and gets confused. So didi has to give special attention to her and then she can understand.



Language

Hindi:-

She can tell fifteen lines stories from her own thoughts. When she tells stories, she tells in a very cute way, with action and makes the sounds of animals. She is a good storyteller. Her pronunciation is not good. In group activity time she doesn't always concentrate, so Didi gives her special attention. She knows some external parts of the body and their functions in Hindi through rhymes.



English: - She can speak a little bit of English and she tries to create her own stories. She can understand English. She played the role of ladybug in the English drama (rainbow) and she sang very well. She could remember her dialogues. She participated in singing on Christmas.

Skill work:-

In skill development activities she likes to do clay modelling and paintings by using her hands. Her fine motor skills are not developed. She takes times in drawing and colouring pictures. She can do some drawings like cloud, rainbow, tree, flowers, butterflies, etc. In paper folding she learnt aeroplane, house, day and night, boat etc.



Project:-

In “my family” project she learnt the relationship with her family members in Hindi and English. When she expresses about her family members, she used her village language. She learnt about her family member through drawing and painting her family tree.



Physical development:-

She likes to play indoor games like fun games, playing with kitchen sets, playing with blocks. She likes to play in the sandpit. She likes to sit alone and play. She also likes to play on the field with her friends. She gets tired after running. When we go for trekking she walks slowly.



Celebrations:-

She likes to perform dance and do make up for dance. When she participates in plays, she takes time to remember her dialogues and she forgets her dialogues while performing and stands looking at the decorations of the stage. Her voice is soft and pronunciation is not clear. She performed dances on Janmastami and Independence Day and did it nicely. On Pranjali bhaiya's birthday she played the role of ladybug in "rainbow" play. On Ganesh puja and Saraswati puja she sang songs with her friends "jay ganesh deva" and "teri binaki ban jaun tar". On Diwali she helped in making diyas and decorating the group. On Christmas she did two action songs with her friends. On Mothers birthday she sang a Sanskrit song and recited students' prayer.
