English

Otherwise, she does maths very well.

She is good in maths. Now she is doing class four book. She takes time to understand the concepts. She needs more practise in four simple operations. In fractions, she knows the way of converting but makes calculation errors. She has learnt proper, improper, mixed, like and unlike fractions and is able to recognize them. After much practise, she is still confused in using am and pm. She can tell time by looking at the clock. She is developing an understanding of place value concepts.
