Simple Machines

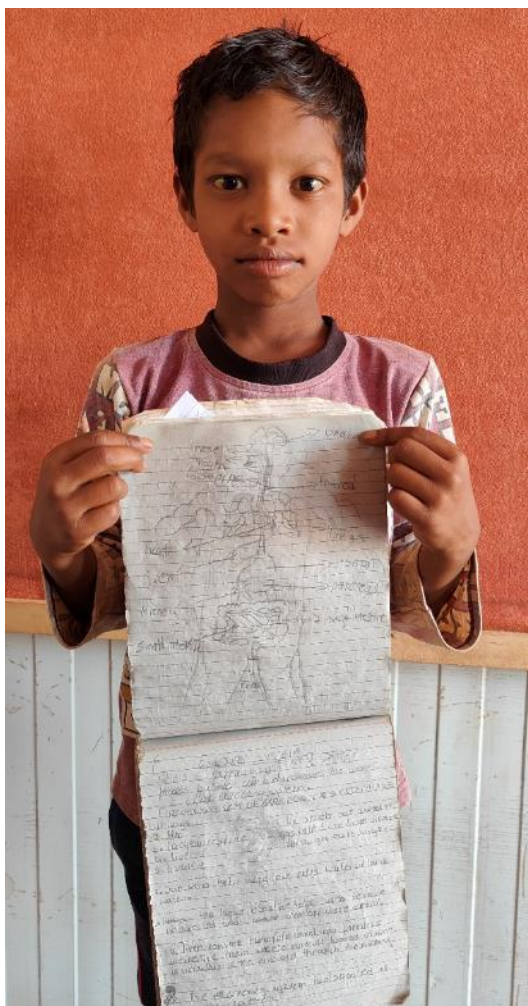

Devendra is focused and attentive in class and willingly participates



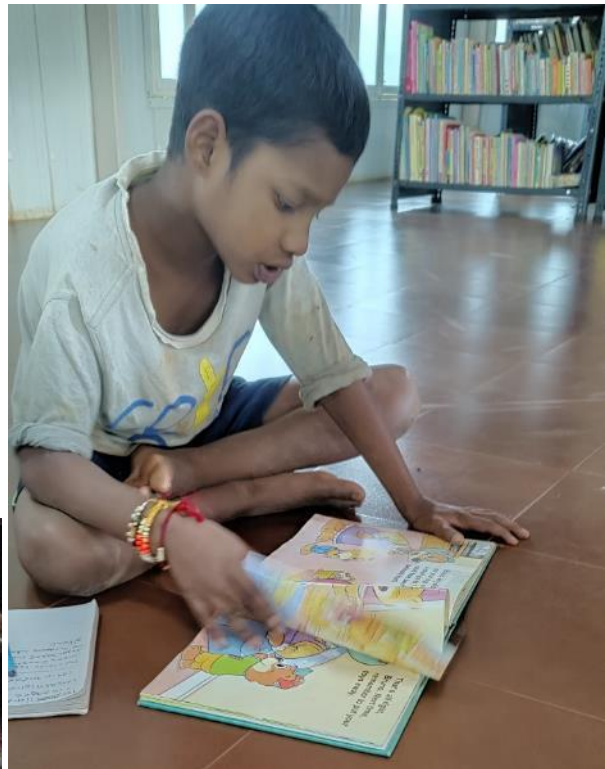
in class discussions. He has a good grasp of all the concepts taught so far. He does not shy away from asking for clarifications when he needs it. He is good at solving word problems but faced problems in

English

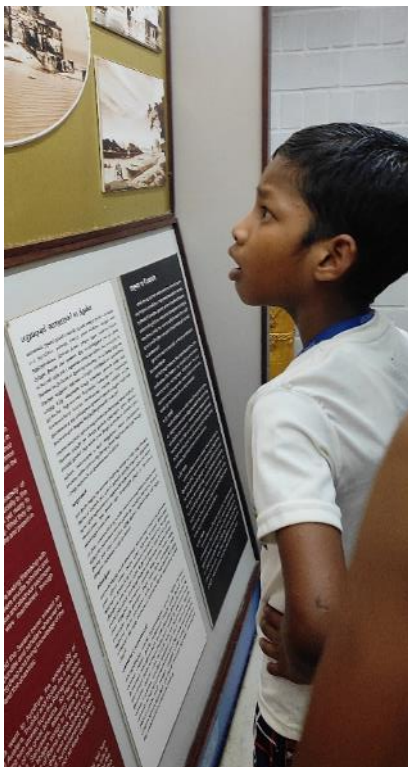
