English

Mathematics

she first started doing maths, she started counting the numbers till twenty and after she was clear, she learnt the numbers after twenty. She was very fast in learning the numbers. But she needs to improve in her pronunciation of numbers. In the mathematics class she has played with the 'jodo cubes', 'aakar parivar' and 'rongometry'. While playing

with these objects she also counted the numbers of objects she had used. While she played with these objects she also learnt the names of different shapes and colours. She can segregate the objects according to their colours and shapes. She also made some 2D and 3D figures and patterns using the shapes of rongometry. In the game 'aakar parivar' she arranged the shapes in ascending and descending orders and also kept the missing shapes in their correct places.



When she was clear in forward counting till hundred, she learnt the backward counting from hundred. Initially she was a bit slow, but she improved very fast. It was a bit tough for her to say the numbers just before 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, and 90 but gradually she got to know them. She also learnt some skip counting in 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 6s. She got to know the patterns very quickly of skip counting and learnt them quickly. She has also learnt addition and a little bit of subtraction till twenty. She is very fast in adding the numbers. She also did the recognition of digits till ten and also learnt to write them. She could recognize the digits by listening to some stories and with songs and by using pictures. She is very interested in doing mathematics.
