

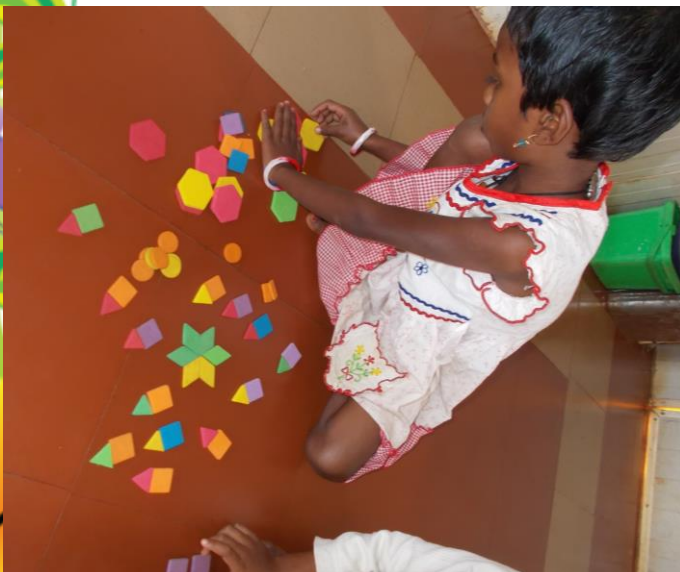
Sakshi Pukia

Hindi:-

She participated in singing Christmas song.

Skills work:-



She likes to do clay modelling. Her drawing skill is good. She likes to draw lots of butterflies and flowers. She also likes to do paintings using her hands. She can fold paper neatly and make toys like aeroplane, house, boat and paper fan. She puts beads in thread and arranges objects on the floor.
