She has shown a lot of improvement in her spellings ever since she was able to distinguish the ring of the words thrown at her.

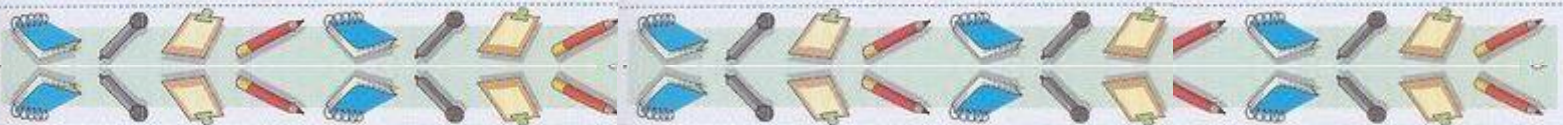
Now is discovering the use of reading. Is able to read well and learn new pronunciations.

Her writing has become clearer but she needs to work on sentence construction and use her creative potential.

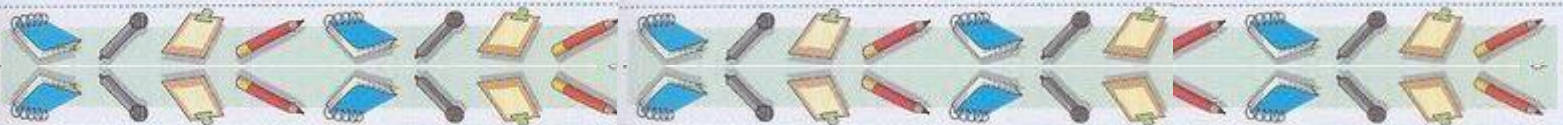


**HOME SCIENCE** - She is a sincere student. In the projects taken up, she pays full attention to her work.

**MATH** - Kokila is working hard in Math. She is more open to accept her mistake now a days and tries to rectify it.

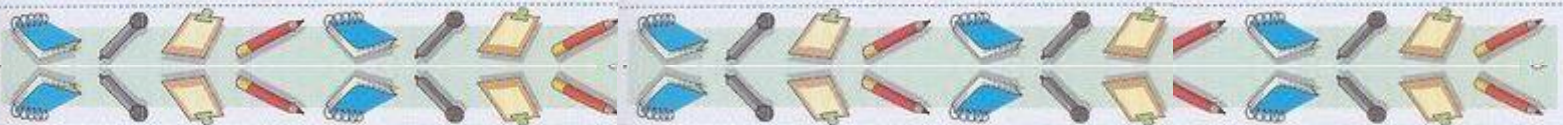
She takes time to understand the concepts. She also needs help to understand and solve problems. Currently she is doing book - IV.
