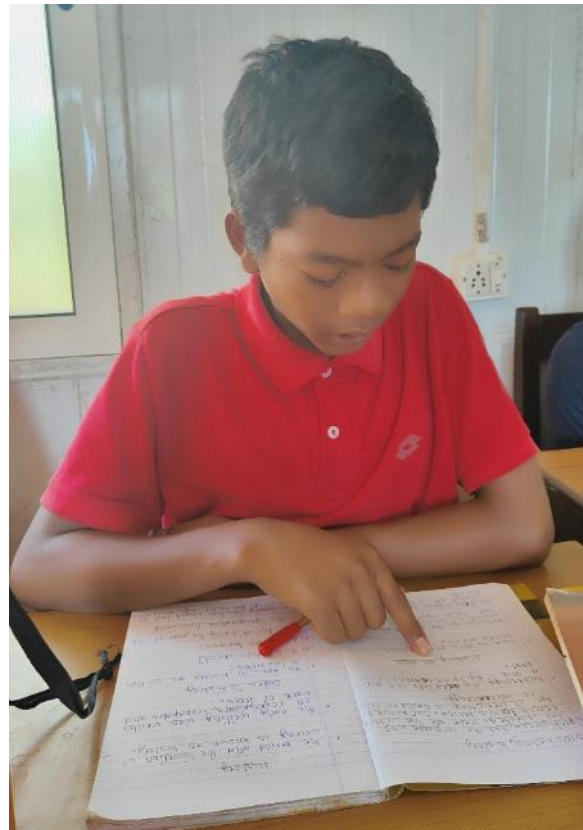
Report for 2023-24 (First Term)

SCIENCE

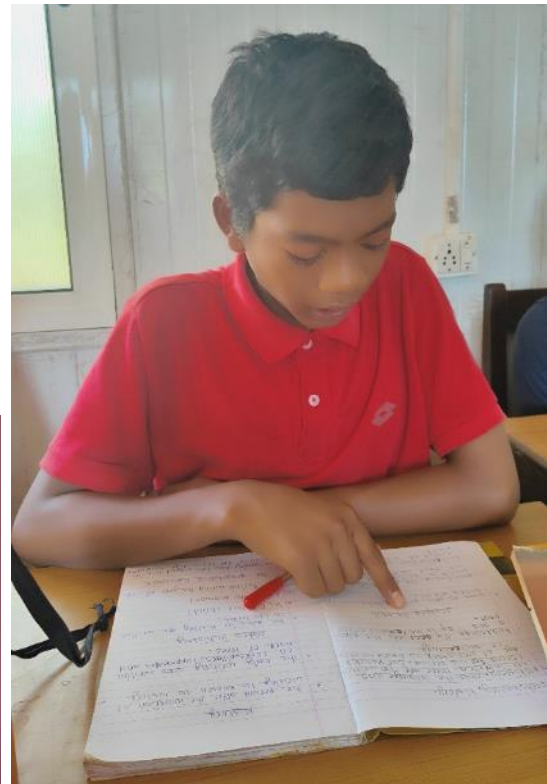
He is a very joyful child, always attentive in class,

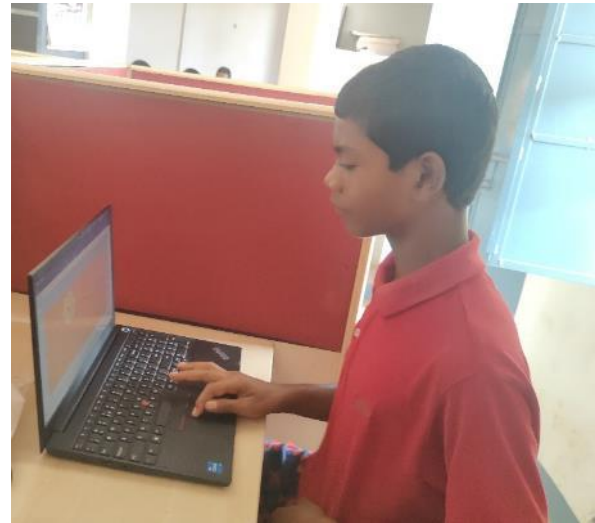
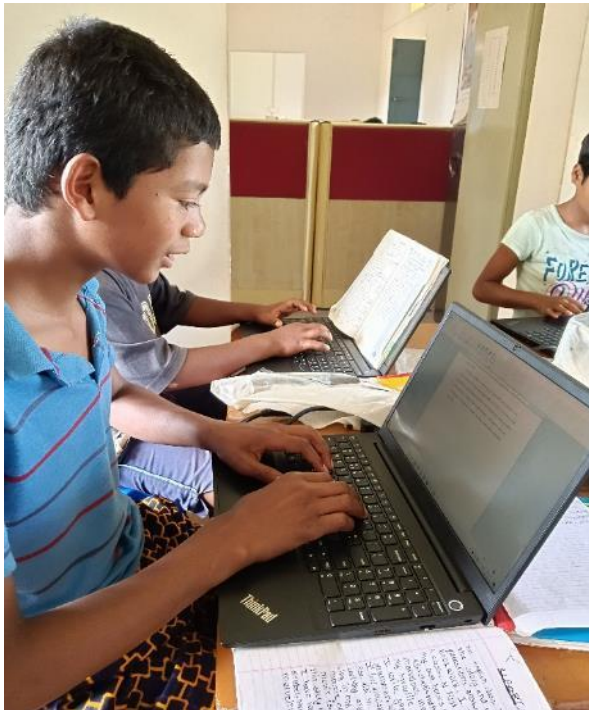
SOCIAL SCIENCE
