Projects

Simple Machines



In this topic, Narsingh participated in all the tasks. He read different books on the simple machines and wrote his understanding. He remembered the different types of simple machines and the three classes of levers. He took the wedge as a part of this topic for making the chart. He wrote about the wedge and made beautiful drawings of the examples of a wedge. He presented very well

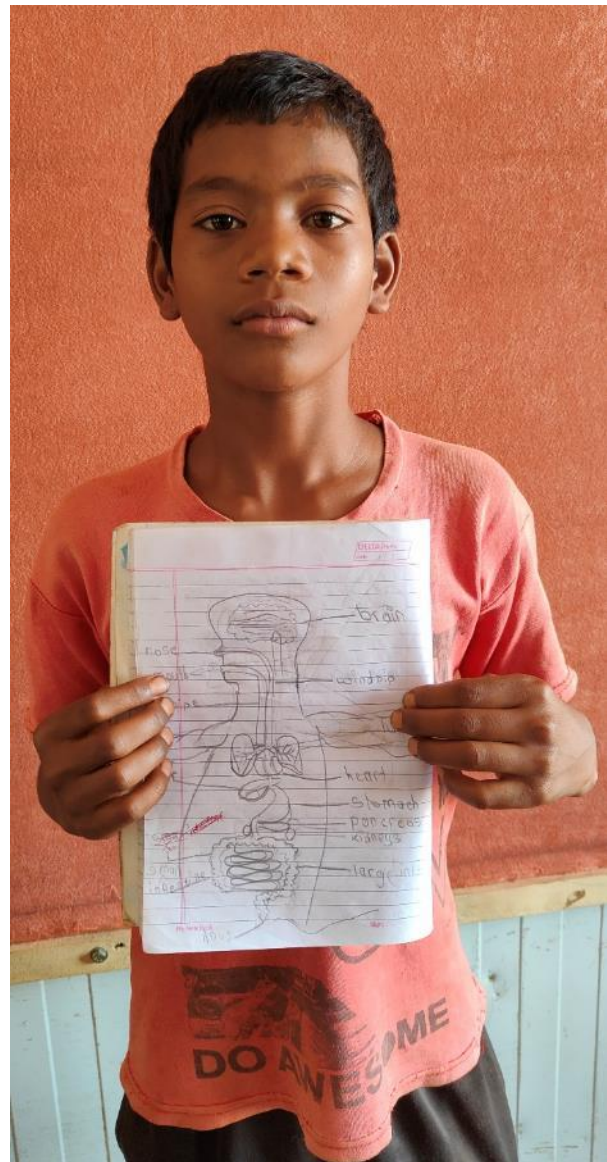
with confidence and using the tools. He collected tools related to wedges from different places for the presentation. For the presentation, he had made an axe with wood.

Human Body Systems

In this topic, he learnt the different types of body systems, their organs, and their functions.

In the skeletal system, he learned about the joints of the bones, their functions, etc. He studied in detail about the ribcage and made a nice drawing of it and also wrote about it for the chart.

In the nervous system topic, he learnt the names of all the organs of the nervous system and remembered them. He also learnt about the different parts of the brain and their functions. He knew the five sense organs and their functions. He made a nice drawing of the brain with labelling for the chart.



He made a nice drawing of the digestive system in his notebook. He remembered all the parts of the digestive system and their functions. He could explain the process of digestion in class nicely. He also knows the function of each digestive organ.

After doing this topic he solved questions from the book. He could solve the short questions and objective-type questions independently and correctly but needed help with the long answer questions. Earlier he used to write the answers in a few words, but now he has started writing in complete sentences.

Countries and capitals



He participated in the group discussions. He learnt the names of the different continents. From the atlas, he found the countries of different continents and wrote their capitals also. He also remembered many of the countries' names and their capitals. He also knows which country belongs to which continent. Personally, he chose Japan, and found out all the facts about Japan and presented them to the group. He took the help of the notes he had made and spoke well.

Civilization



Narsingh was very excited about doing this topic. He always had some points to add to the discussion. We started with early humans and he knew some things about them. He got a good understanding of civilization after doing the topic. He did his work nicely by reading the book and finding out things and making important points in his notebook. He could give a proper explanation about the civilization, religion, occupation, trade, script, etc. He understood very well the town planning of the Indus Valley civilization. Finally, he made a chart with his friends and presented it in class. Whenever he gave a test, he got 80% and above marks.

Maths

In maths, he is doing his fourth book. He has reached the Factors and Multiples chapter. He loves solving word problems but has a little difficulty in understanding the language and sometimes he copies the numbers of the questions wrong so the answer to the question is wrong. In decimals, he finds it difficult



in solving division sums. In the topic of money, he could recognize various types of coins such as 10 paise, 25 paise, 50 paise, etc. He also learned how to convert paise to rupees and how many 25 paise makes 1 rupee, etc., and also did a comparison between the different denominations. For better understanding, he played the game 'Monopoly' with his friends. He needs to concentrate very much while doing maths.

English

Narsingh is a very intelligent boy and he always concentrates. In class, he sits very quietly and when he is asked some



questions then he answers them correctly. He always does his homework before coming to class. His handwriting is very beautiful and his spellings and grammar have improved a lot. In dictation he gets almost all correct. He also has a timetable in the class which he

follows. On Mondays and Wednesdays, he has free reading in which he goes to the library and picks up books of his own choice, and does loud reading. His reading has improved from before. He likes to read many types of books such as Abdul Kalam, Cinderella, stories from Panchatantra, and Jataka tales. On Thursdays he has group reading in which all the children have to read one paragraph. He reads loudly and clearly so that the whole class can hear him. He has already read two books. They are-Charlie and the Chocolate Factory and Fantastic Mr. Fox and he enjoyed them
