We also visited the **Port Blair beach** after the science museum. In the afternoon around 4 pm, we again visited to the Cellular Jail for the 'sound and light show'.





We woke up early in the morning the following day and got ready by 9 am and sat in the bus. Then by a speed boat, we reached the **North Bay Island**. There, the teachers did snorkeling and I was just roaming around here and there. I walked on the beach and collected some shells. Then we went to the **Ross Island**.
