I do *Shramdan* every day from 6:30 to 7:30 except on Sundays and



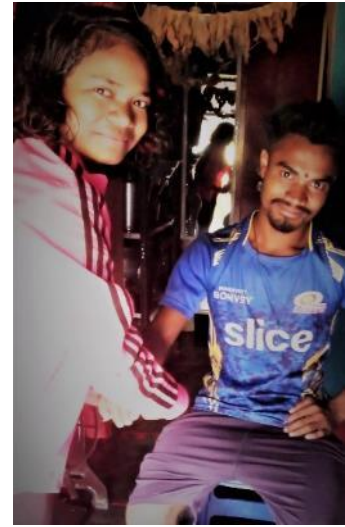
